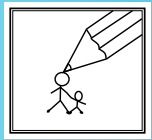


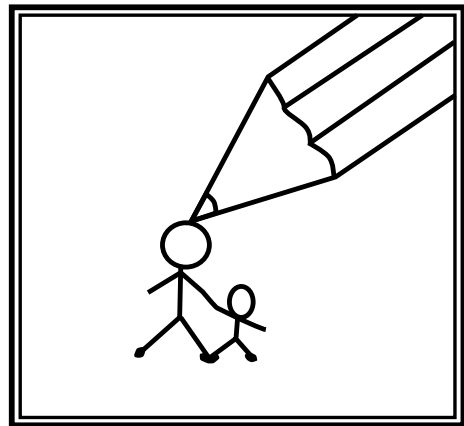

Who we are?

- A free confidential support service for parents and carers of children with special educational needs

Why we are here?

- We are a statutory service who work at arm's length from the authority

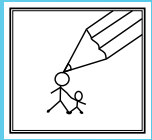
What we do?

- We give free, confidential and impartial information relating to your child's special educational needs
- We run group sessions for parents and carers about the services available in Bedfordshire
- We aim to print regular newsletters to provide help and advice
- We have trained Independent Parental Supporters that may be able to support at a meeting with either the school or Local Authority
- We can provide information regarding Parents' rights and responsibilities, and who you can talk to about your child.

How do we do this?

- We will invite you to one of our information sessions for parents and carers if you or your school has asked for a statutory assessment
- We can provide support for parents/carers in meetings and reviews with schools and the Local Authority
- We can provide advice about how to get your child's special educational needs assessed
- We provide a telephone help line
- We offer a range of leaflets on different aspects of special educational needs
- We can provide contact details of voluntary organisations and support groups
- We can help with filling in forms and writing letters
- We can help with reading through and understanding reports

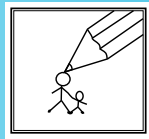
