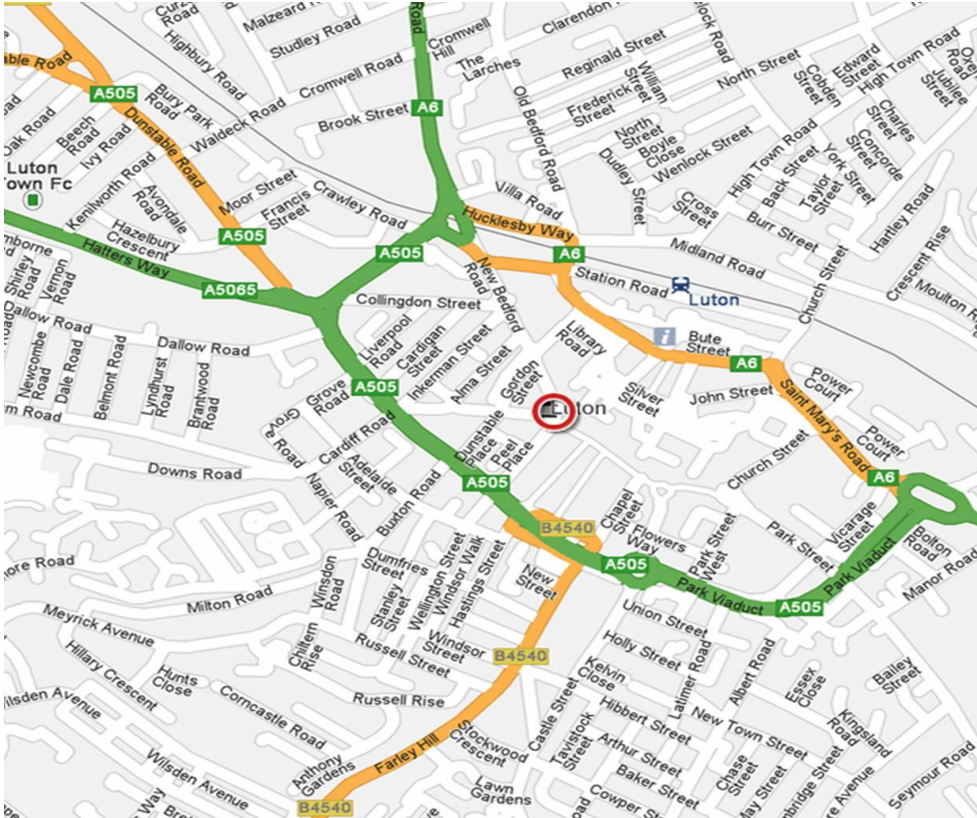

There are courses at different levels so you'll be able to start at the right level for you.

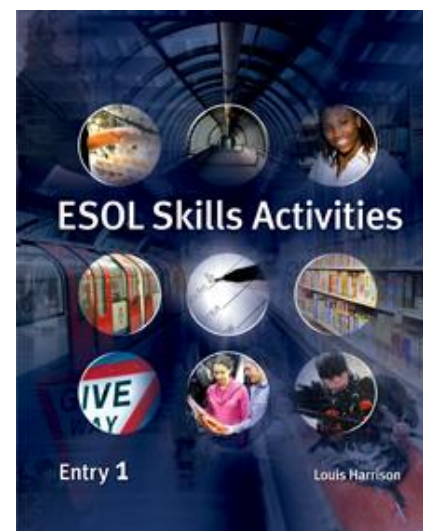

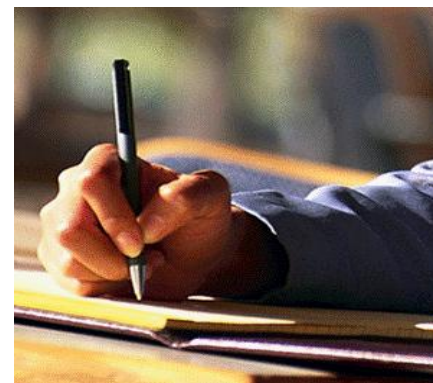
